The objective of the webinar is to make the students to aware the significance of Perovskite solar cells, under the webinar the points discussed were anomalous hysteresis, stability, and lead toxicity of perovskite solar cells, which included investigations to understand the origin of hysteresis, to know whether hysteresis is really a problem for stable power output measured at real use conditions, to check thermal stability of perovskite cells, to explore the possibility of reuse/recycle of degraded perovskite solar cells to avoid toxic Pb-waste, etc. The webinar was conducted on 15th July 2022.
