INFORMATION TO THE STUDENTS

The Graduation Day of Sreenivasa Institute of Technology and Management Studies (SITAMS) (Autonomous) will be organized on 6th October 2024 (Sunday) at 10.00 AM on the College premises for B.Tech / M.Tech / MBA / MCA students who have completed their program in July 2024 respectively. They are advised to confirm their participation in the Graduation Day celebrations and register their names on or before 25th September 2024; and report on 6th October 2024 (Sunday) at 8.30 AM for rehearsal, which is mandatory.

They are requested to observe strictly the following instructions:

- 1. The candidates who wish to receive their provisional pass certificates in person on Graduation Day 2024, must compulsorily register.
- 2. Those who already submitted PC application and NO DUES to the exam section are only eligible to attend the Graduation Day 2024.
- 3. Graduates should give the consent of participation using the following link

- 4. The registered candidates should report strictly before 08.30 AM, 06th October 2024 (Sunday), otherwise they will not be allowed to attend the Graduation Day.
- 5. The graduates who have registered but report after 08.30 AM and those who have not registered can receive the Provisional pass certificates, Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate etc., in the college office after the Graduation Day.
- 6. Candidates are requested to be in their respective seats at the venue by 08.30 AM.
- 7. Graduates shall wear the dress representing Indian Culture/Heritage (White Pant / Shirt for Men; White Half-Saree / White Saree / Salwar Kameez / Pyjama for women).
- 8. No candidate shall be allowed to enter the Venue after 08.30 AM. Candidates who are not dressed according to the regulations will not be admitted into the Venue.

- 9. Candidates are specially requested to take the pledge audibly, after initiation by the Principal.
- 10. Candidates should remain standing when the Chief Guest and other dignitaries enter the Stage and when they retire from the Venue.
- 11. Candidates are strictly forbidden from leaving their place until the Chief Guest and other dignitaries leave the Venue after the dissolution of the Graduation Day.
- 12. Candidates are strictly instructed to observe silence during the proceedings of the Graduation Day.
- 13. Graduates shall maintain the dignity and decorum during the proceedings of the Graduation Day.
- 14. Candidates are directed not to bring Cell Phone/Camera to the Venue.
- 15. Candidates should bring their proof of identity.
- 16. Candidates are requested to occupy the seats allotted to them.
- 17. Photography: Two authorized photographers will be available at the venue to cover the proceedings of the Graduation Day and capture the group photographs of the students of respective departments at the venues decided.
