This has reference to the proposal submitted by Sreenivasa Institute of Technology and Management Studies, Murukambattu Post, Chittoor – 517127 for extension of Autonomous Status.

The Commission, at its meeting held on 27.08.2024, has approved the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Autonomous Colleges to extend the autonomous status to Sreenivasa Institute of Technology and Management Studies, Murukambattu Post, Chittoor – 517127 affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Anantpur. for a period of 05 years from the academic year 2024-2025 to 2028-2029 as per clause 8.1 of the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023.

The University, is therefore, requested to issue necessary notification within 30 days regarding the extension of autonomous status to the college as per UGC Regulations of Autonomous Colleges, 2023.

The autonomous college is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges, 2023. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugc.gov.in. Noncompliance of the requirements and conditions prescribed in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -13 of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges, 2023. The college shall apply to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status at least three months before the completion of autonomy period.
