MEASURES TAKEN TO AVOID THE RAGGING IN THE CAMPUS

a) An disciplinary committee is formed in SITAMS, Chittoor. The committee in full or parts may be called upon to make surprise raids on hostels & other hot spots like college bus stop / college Railway station and will be empowered to inspect places of potential ragging. The Squad will work under the overall guidance of anti-ragging committee.



- Students should display identity cards on person in the campus. Should follow neat dress code.
 - (Boys-formal shirts and pants with tuck in. Cirls-chudidhars with dhupatta.
- Students should be punctual to the classes. They will not be permitted into the class 5 minutes after the commencement of the class.
- No student shall leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher or until the class is over.
- Students should maintain strict discipline inside the class rooms as well as in the college campus. They should keep the class rooms/college campus neat and tidy
- Students should not use cell phones in the college. If any student is found with a cell phone, it will be taken away from him/her and confiscated by the principal as a part of disciplinary action.
- No student should be present in the canteen during the class work.
- No student is permitted to roam in the campus during class/Lab work.
- Students are expected to spend their free time in the Library.

- Ragging is strictly prohibited as per Government Orders.
 - Students should not bring any unauthorized persons into the campus.
- Any student involved in breaking or damaging any college property shall be punished severely.
- Criticizing or abusing the girl students in foul language is strictly prohibited in the campus.
- Organizing birthday or any other personal functions within the campus is strictly prohibited.
- Students are expected to behave well with the, staff, other students and general public. Any misbehavior coming to the notice of the college authorities will be severely dealt with.
- The conduct of the students should be exemplary not only within the premises of the college but also outside. This will help in maintaining the image and status o the college.

MEASURES TAKEN TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE GIRL STUDENTS IN OUR CAMPUS

Women's Empowerment cell:

- A committee comprising lady staff members is constituted which takes care of women's issues.
- The cell conducts regular meetings with professional counselors. The college also houses a dedicated Common Girls Room with first aid facilities.
- To address the complaints filed by the girls and lady faculty, this cell was constituted under the leader of senior lady faculty and the warden
- This cell looks after the issues related safety of the girl students and encourages the students to lodge complaints fearlessly
- The entire college campus has full CCTV coverage. A special staff was appointed exclusively to monitor the CCTV.
- The cell has informed the nearest police station about the location of the hostel and requested the Sub inspector to visit the college often.
- It is decided to keep the police station number and help line number fixed on the outer board at the entrance.
- In this connection all Heads of Departments are instructed to bring the above Rules and regulations to the notice of senior students for prevention and prohibition of ragging in this college.

Annexure - I

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- Indulging in rowdy or in disciplined activities by any student or students which
 causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or
 to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course
 do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame,or torment
 or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher
 or any other student;
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing theacademic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harmor any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- Any act that affects the mental health and self- confidence of a fresher or any other student
- With or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Administrative action in the event of ragging

- 1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- 2. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- 3. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- 4. Withholding results.
- 5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 6. Suspension/Expulsion from the hostel.
- 7. Cancellation of admission.
- 8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to anyother institution for a specified period

Punishment

The following are the Punishments that may be imposed on a student.

Minor Penalties

- 1. Oral/Written Warning
- 2. Suspension form the class for a week

Major Penalties

- 1. Suspending from class for one month/semester.
- 2. Prevention from appearing University Exams.
- 3. Prevention form T& P facilities.
- 4. Suspension from Hostel
- 5. Rustication from college.


