Agenda 1:

Curriculum Aspects

- > The Committee has reviewed the action taken report of the previous semester feedback to improve the quality of teaching process. The committee emphasized the need for the faculty members to strictly adhere to the lesson plan, and the need to officially seek approval from the respective head of the department in case of any deviation from the lesson plan. Chairperson of IQAC expressed that

- > IQAC Coordinator suggested that teachers should enroll themselves in online courses offered by the NPTEL and thereby encourage students to take the courses.

Teaching Learning Evaluation:

- ➤ The Committee has reviewed the action taken report on AY 2022-2023 and advised to segregate the subjects under three categories(I,e Easy, Moderate and Difficult) to set the targets for result analysis in the Academic year 2023-2024.
- > All HoDs are informed to monitor the discipline, Antiragging and mentoring to ensure the academic and behavioral discipline among the students. For this, HoDs are asked to make frequent rounds while the classes are in the progress to ensure both the faculty and the students are adhering to the plans and schedules.
