Action Taken:

The Key highlights are,

- 3. HR Policies with monetary benefits for good faculty retention, Skill upgradation for technical staff (Human Resource-policies)
- 4. Enhanced Focus on student diversity, Entrepreneurship skill development and motivation to improve higher study rate (Human Resource Students)
- Financial support for faculty publications in SCI/Scopus/UGC CARE listed journals, Need to organize more number FDPs and Research Funding Proposals to get possible grants (Research and Development).

- 7. Linkages, Corporate support, Alumni & Community engagement need more focus for enhancing the quality standards.
