Initiatives, Activities and Action Taken Report

- 1. A total of 429 Text books and Reference books were added to the existing library books at the cost of Rs.1,90,605/- .
- 2. New Journals were added to the digital library.
- 3. Eight New e-Journals were added to the digital library.
- 4. E-Learning resources were increased with inclusion of 126 CD and Videos.
- 5. Orientation program was conducted for the Ist year students.
- Outcome-Based Education (OBE) model has been streamlined and adapted in practice to enhance quality standards.
- 7. Faculty members were encouraged to adopt Innovative Teaching Tractices and maximize the adoption of ICT Tools in their teaching methods.
- 8. Faculty members were motivated to attend refresher courses, orientation programs, summer schools, workshop, FDP, etc.
- 9. All the braches were encouraged to conduct value added course.
- 10. Access to NPTEL Video Lectures for various domain areas in the Digital Library was given for students and faculty members.
- 11. Class committee meetings were conducted regularly to enhance the quality standards in teaching and learning process.
- 12. Online multiple choice questions were implemented.
- 13. Remedial classes were conducted for various subjects to support academically weak students.
- 14. A total of 130 computers with latest configuration and high speed computers were purchased (Rs.60,68,056/-) to upgrade the facilities in the computer labs to support in adoption to the recent Trends and Technology.
- 15. Computer Integrated Manufacturing Facility was newly established. Computer Numerical Control Lathe Machine (model: TUTOR) has been purchased at the cost of 14.57 lakhs for Mechanical Engineering Department during July 2017.
- CATIA V6 –Essentials for academic Small Packages (UXK-S-P) 30 licenses and SIMULIA V5-Academic Teaching Suite 20 users, have been purchased at the cost of Rs 7.97 lakhs, during July 2017.
- 17. Research and Development cell has taken several initiatives in organizing seminars, workshops, etc, to do good research and publish papers in peer reviewed and reputed journals.
- 18. ISRO-IIRS SITAMS remote centre has organized different outreach programs.
- To enhance the technical skills, Value Added Courses through IIT-Bombay spoken tutorial was conducted for students.
- 20. Entrepreneurship Development Cell has organized periodical meetings with industrialists, entrepreneurs and chief executives of various concerns to enhance the entrepreneurship skills among the students.
- 21. Industry Institute Interaction cell has taken several measures by organizing Guest Lectures, Seminars, Workshops, Conferences, Industry Visits, In-plant Training, Internships, etc.
- 22. Training and Placement cell conducted 12 training events on various employability skills given by Organization like WAYS OPEN CONSULTANTS Pvt Ltd, Chennai, Cerf Study Springs Pvt Ltd Salem, GLOBAL TALENT TRACK, Pune, VIT placement consortium along with regular internal training events.
