⇒ Tag means adding some force is called

Question Tag.

⇒ Question Tag is used for confirming the action in the sentence or question form

Ex: You came to college → Didn't you?

⇒ we use different question tags in different situations but, it depends on helping verbs and pronoun merely.

i) Positive statement takes negative tags.

is/are
Helping Verb + not + Pronoun?

Ex: She is singing a song → Is + not + she → Isn't she?

ii) The negative statement takes positive tags.

Helping verb + Pronoun.
Is she

Rule No-01:

Though the statement is given with noun, but we should use only pronoun in the tag.

Ex: Baby writes a letter → Does + not + she → Doesn't she?

Rule No-02:

A suggestion that uses "let's" takes "shall we" in the tag.

Ex: let's have a game of chess. Shall we?

Rule No-03:

If there is no auxiliary verb in the statement do, does, did are used

Ex: She likes music → does + not + she → Doesn't she?

Rule No-04:

Everybody, No body, No one, Everyone are singular
But, in Framing question tag they are considered
to be plural and pronoun 'They' is used

Ex: Everyone can walk well → can + not + they
can't they?

Rule No-05:

With imparative statements expressing in an order
commant (or) request in that case will, would,
can, could are used in the question tags?

Ex: Close the window → Will you?
Help me with this luggage → Could you?
