

1. What are skimming and scanning?

Skimming :- Quick Reading to get the main idea of a passage without focusing details.

Example :- Headlines.

Scanning :- Reading quickly to find specific information, like dates, names or key words.

2. Define the term Intra Personal Communication?

Intra personal communication can be defined as the communication with ourselves like self talk, self thinking and inner speech is known as Intra personal communication.

Example :- prayers, Recitations etc..

3. What is narrative essay?

A narrative essay is a type of writing that tells a story about in a real or imaginary experience it includes events in sequence and often has a messages or lesson.

Example :- I went to the park and played with my friends It was a happy day.

4. What is expository essay?

An expository essay is a type of writing that explain or gives information about a topic in a clear and simple way.

Example:- what is important for life. It helps our body stay healthy and keeps us active

5. What is collocations give example?

Collocations are natural combination of words that are closely associated with each other. They can be made of any kinds of words such as verbs, nouns, adverbs and adjectives.

Examination :- Classroom, fast food, heavy rain.

6. Define homophones give example?

Homophones are words that same pronunciation but different meaning and spellings.

Example:- Sun / son, right / write.

7. Define homonyms give example?

Homonyms are words that have the same

spelling or same sound but different meaning.

Ex :- bank (riverside) / bank (money place).

8.) What is self-esteem?

Self-esteem is the way a person feels about their own worth or value. It reflects confidence and self respect.

Example:- A student who believes "I can do this exam well" has good self-esteem.

9. Explain the term non-verbal communication.

Non-verbal communication is the exchange of information without using words, through gestures, facial expressions, body language etc...

Example :- Smiling shows happiness without speaking

10. Discuss the central theme of the poem "Notebook".

The central theme of the poem "Notebook" is the importance of learning, knowledge, and preserving thoughts or memories. It highlights how a notebook reflects a student's efforts and ideas.

**Example:-** A student's notebook showing reflects hard work and creativity.

11. What are content words and functional words?

Content words carry meaning (nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs), while functional words connect sentences (articles, prepositions, conjunctions).

**Example :-** In the sentence "She is reading a book".
